THE COORDINATORS

The Club Coordinators will be in charge of the smooth functioning of the Club. They will be assisted in this by the Circle Coordinators.

The Club Coordinators will be from the final year students, while the Circle Coordinators will be from across all batches, with representation from each batch in one or more Circle.

Each individual will be a coordinator for only one Club/Circle. However, the Clubs & Circles may interact across each other's work areas and function together as a team, depending on the kind of event that is planned.

The Coordinators will be responsible for the organising and management of all events. The events could be mere interactions between Club/Circle members or even workshops, screenings, interactions with subject experts & celebrities, staging of shows & competitions, etc.

They will also be responsible for ensuring that all equipment, lights, etc. are properly switched off at the end of each Club meeting.
